Danica McKellar will play the role of AERO in the animated sequel "FLATLAND 2: Sphereland".

Danica is best known as "Winnie Cooper" on *The Wonder Years*. She is now a three-time New York Times bestselling author with her groundbreaking books: *Math Doesn't Suck*, *Kiss My Math* and *Hot X: Algebra Exposed*.

In the film Danica plays Aero, the captain for Flatland's first rocket mission into their "outer-space".
